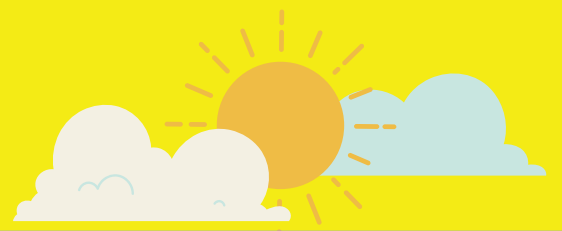


17 January 2025 NEWSLETTER
